WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

COMPALED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we C.B. Lynch & Jay Forsythe and C.B. Lynch & Jennie Forsythe, their
~~his wife~~ for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred (\$300.00) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said S.S. Miller and unto Lisa heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot nineteen & twenty (19 & 20) Block nine (9) Lynch & Forsythe's addition
to Tulsa Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said S.S. Miller and unto Lisa heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said S.S. Miller that will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

So being agreed by S.S. Miller in the acceptance of this deed that there is to be no drilling for oil or
gas on above lots.
 And we C.B. Lynch & Jennie Forsythe wife of the said C.B. Lynch & Jay Forsythe for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said S.S. Miller all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
