## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, I, Mammie Delk and a single person,  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred DOLLARS,  
to me paid by the Deacons and members of the First  
Baptist Church of Broken Arrow, Ind. Ter. do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Deacons of said Baptist Church successors in office or  
 and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots numbers Nine (9) and ten (10) in Block number  
Forty four (44) in the town of Broken Arrow, Indian  
Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Deacons of said Baptist Church and unto their heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Deacons of said Baptist Church that I will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mammie Delk, wife of the said \_\_\_\_\_ for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said First Baptist Church all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
