WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we A. M. Brannon and Rebecca E. Brannon
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid by W. M. Wilson and Ruth A. Davis the
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said W. M. Wilson and Ruth A. Davis and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

the south 1/2 of Lot number five (5) in Block numbered
one hundred seven (107) as shown by the Government
Plat of said City of Tulsa approved by the secretary of
the Interior

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. M. Wilson and Ruth A. Davis and unto their heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And, hereby covenant with said W. M. Wilson and Ruth A. Davis that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever. Except the claims of two minor heirs which interest
is protected by bond, executed by R. R. Roberts this date.

And I, Rebecca E. Brannon, wife of the said A. M. Brannon for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. M. Wilson and Ruth A. Davis all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
