WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we William M. Pyle and Kittie V. Pyle
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) DOLLARS,
To us in hand paid, by Berin Stepler, the receipt whereof
is here-by acknowledged. do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Berin Stepler and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Muskogee (Creek Nation) Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot Numbered Four (4) in Block numbered Twenty-seven (27) in the
Town of Red Fork, Muskogee (Creek) Nation, aforesaid, and according
to the plat of file in said District
And party of the second part agree to accept and pay the taxes
due on said property for the year 1906

To have and to hold the same unto the said Berin Stepler and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Berin Stepler that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Kittie V. Pyle, wife of the said William M. Pyle for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Berin Stepler all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
