WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said W. M. Wilson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot 17 in Block 7 situated in Bellevue add. to Tulsa D.T.

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. M. Wilson and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. M. Wilson that he will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Chas. W. Grimes, wife of the said Chas. W. Grimes for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. M. Wilson all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
