WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of eighty (80) DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the Grantors,
 do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Matilda A. Reneau, Tulsa Ind. Ter. and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots four (4) and five (5) Block twenty-two, West Tulsa,
Creek Nation Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Matilda A. Reneau and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Matilda A. Reneau that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John O. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Matilda A. Reneau all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
