WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Jon Hall and Jennie S. Hall his wife J. M. Gillette and
Minnie M. Gillette his wife and J. M. Harker and Carrie Harker
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid by Frank J. Miigere and
Bertha Miigere husband and wife the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Frank J. Miigere and Bertha Miigere
 and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots seven (7) & eight (8) in Block nineteen (19)
in the Gillette Hall Addition to the City of
Tulsa Indian Territory, according to the recorded
plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said F. J. Miigere and Bertha Miigere
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Frank Miigere and Bertha Miigere
 title of said lands against all claims whatever. exception of and release to Grant C.
Stebbins and his assigns

And I, Jennie S. Hall, wife of the said Jon Hall and J. M. Harker wife of said J. M. Harker
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank J. Miigere and Bertha Miigere
 all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
