WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Louis A. Tyler and Carrie V. Tyler  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Fifty 99/100 DOLLARS,  
 to them paid Cash in hand the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
 as received from John H. Danieel of Shiatosh, Ind Terr do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said John H. Danieel and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots number twenty (20) and twenty one (21) all in Block  
number thirty nine within the original town of Shiatosh  
Ind Terr Western District

To have and to hold the same unto the said John H. Danieel and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John H. Danieel that they will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I Carrie V. Tyler wife of the said Louis A. Tyler for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John H. Danieel all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
