## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we C. G. Tinklepaugh and Anna Tinklepaugh  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred DOLLARS,  
to them paid Cash in hand the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
 do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said G. F. Bengel and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots Twenty-three (23) and twenty-four (24) in Block Seven (7) in the  
Town of Skiatook Indian Territory according to the recorded  
plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said G. F. Bengel and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said G. F. Bengel that he will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Anna Tinklepaugh, wife of the said C. G. Tinklepaugh for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said G. F. Bengel all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
