WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Lila D Lindsey and L W Lindsey her husband
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred & Twenty-five (\$325.00) DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Ernest L Wilson the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged and conferred do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Ernest L Wilson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Second Lindsey Addition to the Town of Tulsa, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot three (3) in Block Ten (10) in the Second Lindsey
Addition to the town of Tulsa, Indian Territory according
to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ernest L Wilson and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant 3 with said Ernest L Wilson that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L W Lindsey husband wife of the said Lila D Lindsey for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ernest L Wilson my entire rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
