WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Ernest L. Wilson and Carrie M. Wilson
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred and 20/100 DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid by Robert J. Corlett, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Robert J. Corlett and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the City of Tulsa (Lindsey second addition) Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot three (3) in Block ten (10) according to the survey and
recorded plat of Lindsey second addition to the City of
Tulsa, Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Robert J. Corlett and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Robert J. Corlett that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Carrie M. Wilson, wife of the said Ernest L. Wilson, for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Robert J. Corlett all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
