OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Jennie Ringel (nee) Brink and
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and 75/100 DOLLARS,
 in hand paid by Elliott S. Brink, the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Elliott S. Brink and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot No Six (6) in Block No five (5) in the Bellview Addition
to the city of Tulsa, Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Elliott S. Brink and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Elliott S. Brink that I will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jennie Ringel (nee) Brink, wife of the said Elliott S. Brink, for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Elliott S. Brink all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
