WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we M. V. Adams and Sarilda J. Adams
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred DOLLARS,
in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledge do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said George W. Adams and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

An undivided one-half interest in Lot 27 Blk
(4) Belview Addition to the Town of Tulsa I.T.

To have and to hold the same unto the said George W. Adams and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George W. Adams that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Sarilda J. Adams, wife of the said M. V. Adams for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George W. Adams all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
