WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we L. B. Lynch and E. J. Lynch
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Rosa M. Woods and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Squash Half (1/2) of Lot One (1) Block One Hundred & Forty Six (146)
having a frontage of fifty (50) feet on South Detroit Ave.
by one hundred & forty feet deep (140) as per the Government
Survey of the Incorporated City of Tulsa, P. T.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Rosa M. Woods and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Rosa M. Woods that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever. Except (81650) Mortgage favor Santa Fe Mortgage
Company, dated June 15-1906 and Title for 1906 which was assumed by Rosa M. Woods

And I, E. J. Lynch, wife of the said L. B. Lynch for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Rosa M. Woods all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
