WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said *John O. Fourshee* and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the *Cherokee Nation* Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

*The South forty (540 ft.) feet of lot number Eleven (11) in Block
 number One (1) in the Turkey Addition to the town of Tulsa,
 as shown by the recorded plat thereof.*

To have and to hold the same unto the said *John O. Fourshee* and unto *his* heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *John O. Fourshee* that *he* will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, ~~the wife of the said~~ *D. A. P. Lewis*, for and in consideration of the said sum of
~~money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said~~ *John O. Fourshee* all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
