WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That ~~we~~ *John O. Mitchell* and *Alice M. Mitchell* ^{his wife} and *W. P. Moore* and *Anna E. Moore*
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of *Sixty Two* $50/100$ DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid by *Lawrence Jolidon*, the receipt of which is
 hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto *the* *Lawrence Jolidon* and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the *Moore addition to West Tulsa, Creek Nation*, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

*all of lots numbered three (3), in block number Seven (7), situate
 in Moore addition to West Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian
 Territory, according to the recorded plat filed thereof.*

To have and to hold the same unto the said *Lawrence Jolidon* and unto *his* heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant *we* with said *Lawrence Jolidon* that *we* will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

and *Anna E. Moore* wife of the said *W. P. Moore*
 And I, *Alice M. Mitchell*, wife of the said *John O. Mitchell*, for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *Lawrence Jolidon* all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
