WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we A. P. Fillepot and Alma Fillepot and
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty and no/100 DOLLARS,
The receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said John D. Wynn and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
an undivided one half (1/2) interest in the east half (1/2) of the
East half (1/2) of the south west quarter (1/4) of the East west quarter (1/4) of the
North east quarter (1/4) of section eighteen (18) Township thirteen (13) north of
Range twelve (12) east situate in the Creek Nation western district Indian
territory containing two and one half (2 1/2) acres according to the recorded
Plot of Henry
To have and to hold the same unto the said John D. Wynn and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John D. Wynn that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alma Fillepot, wife of the said A. P. Fillepot for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John D. Wynn all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
