## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Aurilia C Hawkins a single woman  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,  
in hand Paid, the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said A L Hawkins and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lot (11) eleven in Block ten (10) in the Hodge Addition  
to the city of Tulsa Indian Territory according  
to the approved Plat thereof said lot being fifty (50)  
feet front by (140) feet deep

To have and to hold the same unto the said A L Hawkins and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S with said A L Hawkins that he will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Aurilia C Hawkins wife of the said A L Hawkins for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A L Hawkins all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
