WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Anna Glenderson and William Glenderson
her husband
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
in hand paid by T. S. Truelove the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said T. S. Truelove and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot One (1) in Block nine (9) in Lindsey's
second addition to the City of Tulsa Indian
Territory according to survey and plat thereof
This deed is made to correct a certain deed
dated March 13 1907 filed for record March 19 1907
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To have and to hold the same unto the said T. S. Truelove and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said T. S. Truelove that one will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, William Glenderson husband of the said Anna Glenderson for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said T. S. Truelove all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
