cash in hand this day paid by Vernon J. Trebault
of Emmit Texas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Vernon J. Trebault and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot nine (9), in Block Six (6), in Lindsey's Addition
to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory, according to the
recorded plat of said addition.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Vernon J. Trebault and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Vernon J. Trebault that he will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

I hereby covenant that I am single and unmarried
 And I, Margaret McEntire, wife of the said Vernon J. Trebault for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
