## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we W. E. Campbell and Emily M. Campbell  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by John Simpson  
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and consent do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said John Simpson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot eleven (11) in Block Two (2) in the George  
Prayman addition to the City of Tulsa Indian  
Territory according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said John Simpson and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John Simpson that we will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily M. Campbell, wife of the said W. E. Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John Simpson all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
