## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Jim Hall and Jennie S. Hall and his wife J. M. Gillette and Minnie M. Gillette his wife and J. W. Hocker and Carrie H. Hocker his wife  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty (\$125.00) DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid by Lillia D. Mapes receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Lillia D. Mapes and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot eight in Block twelve of the Gillette Hall addition to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Lillia D. Mapes and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Lillia D. Mapes that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever, except an oil and Gas lease held by Hunt & Stebbins or his assigns.

And I, Jennie S. Hall, wife of the said Jim Hall, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lillia D. Mapes all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
