OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Edward J. Booth and Nancy C. Booth
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred DOLLARS,
in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said C. A. Munsey and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
all of Lots five (5) six (6), and seven (7) in
Block six (6) of Dawson Indian Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said C. A. Munsey and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. A. Munsey that I will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Nancy C. Booth wife of the said Edward J. Booth for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. A. Munsey all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
