## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. W. Blackmore and Larena Blackmore  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten hundred and fifty DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said W. A. Chastain and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot Three (3) in Block Seven (7), in the  
Order addition to the City of Tulsa Indian  
Territory as is shown by the amended  
plat and survey thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. A. Chastain and unto his heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S with said W. A. Chastain that we will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Larena Blackmore wife of the said J. W. Blackmore for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. A. Chastain all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
