WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. M. Gillette, Minnie M. Gillette, J. M. Hall, Jennie S. Hall
W. H. Harker, Carrie S. Harker
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of 25.00 DOLLARS,
 in hand paid by Lucia A. Fuller, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Lucia A. Fuller and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot numbered fifteen (15) in Block number
thirteen (13) in the Gillette Hall Addition to the
City of Tulsa according to the recorded plat
thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said Lucia A. Fuller and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Lucia A. Fuller that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever, except one oil and gas lease to Grant
W. Harker or his assigns
Jennie S. Hall wife of the said J. M. Hall and Carrie S. Harker wife of the
said W. Harker and I, Minnie M. Gillette wife of the said J. M. Gillette, for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lucia A. Fuller all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
