WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Thomas Hisswall and Aileen Hisswall
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five hundred DOLLARS,
in hand paid by T. S. Chambers, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged. do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said T. S. Chambers and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots one, two, three, four and five (1-2-3-4-5) in block
two (2) in River Ford addition to the town of Tulsa Ind, Terr.

To have and to hold the same unto the said T. S. Chambers and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said T. S. Chambers that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

Except an oil and gas lease thereon
 And I, Aileen Hisswall, wife of the said T. S. Chambers for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said T. S. Chambers all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
