WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

 to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and
 confessed as having been this day paid by T. M. Ryan do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said T. M. Ryan and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot number five (5) in block number one hundred thirty six
(136) in the town of Tulsa, according to the U.S. Government survey
and plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said T. M. Ryan and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said T. M. that he will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, _____, wife of the said _____ for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____ all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
