## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we *J. M. Hall and Jennie M. Hall his wife* and *Minnie M. Killett his wife and J. H. Hooker and*  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of *One hundred and fifty \$150.00* DOLLARS,  
*to us in hand paid by William Moore French, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged*  
 do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said *William Moore French* and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the *Sevek Nation* Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

*Lot ten (10) in block one (1) in the Killett-Hall addition to the*  
*city of Tulsa Indian Territory, according to the recorded plat thereof*

To have and to hold the same unto the said *William Moore French* and unto *his* heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *William Moore French* that *we* will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever. *except an oil and gas lease to Grant C. Stillman or his*

*Minnie M. Killett wife of J. M. Killett and J. H. Hooker wife of said J. H. Hooker*  
 And I, *Jennie M. Hall*, wife of the said *J. M. Hall* and *his* for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *William Moore French* all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
