KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

and other valuable considerations

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Gabriel M. Wright Jr. and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the North Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

lot four (4) in block 16 (6) North Tulsa, of the City of Tulsa  
Indian Territory, according to the Government plat and survey now  
on file

To have and to hold the same unto the said Gabriel M. Wright Jr. and unto his heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Gabriel M. Wright Jr. that they will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. C. Ingram husband, wife of the said Lelasa M. Ingram for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Gabriel M. Wright Jr. all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
