WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Adelta F. Berry a single woman and of Tulsa Indian Territory
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and twenty (\$320.00) DOLLARS,
cash to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said J. L. Gray and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 26 and 27 being 44 feet in block 14 in the Berry addition
to the city of Tulsa

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. L. Gray and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto in anywise belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. L. Gray that she will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, _____, wife of the said _____ for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____ all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
