**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we F. Marshall and M. J. Marshall his wife and M. T. Self  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty seven (\$57.00) DOLLARS,  
cash on hand paid by Helen E. Lacey of Okmulgee Ind. Ter. the receipt of which is  
hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Helen E. Lacey and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
Lot two five (5) in block No. 101 of town of Okmulgee Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Helen E. Lacey and unto her heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Helen E. Lacey that they will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever, except oil & gas now out standing against said land

And M. J. Marshall his wife of the said F. Marshall & M. T. Self for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Helen E. Lacey all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
