## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. H. Hall and May E. Hall  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred eighty seven & 50/100 DOLLARS,  
in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said John Hatcher and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot eight 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> block eight 18<sup>th</sup> section by the plat of the town of  
Turkey, Indian Territory  
together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in  
any way appertaining

To have and to hold the same unto the said John Hatcher and unto his heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John Hatcher that we will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, May E. Hall, wife of the said J. H. Hall for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John Hatcher all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
