# GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

## WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 3 day of Sept 1907 one thousand nine hundred and 7 by and between Jessie M. Moreland a single person of Stillwell Dist of part 4 of the first part, and A. B. Potter of Chandler Oklahoma of part 4 of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said part 4 of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred & no/100 DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do ES hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 4 of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The southeast Quarter SE 1/4 of the northwest Quarter NW 1/4 of the north west quarter NW 1/4 of Section 15 Township 22 N. Range 14 East, East of the Indian meridian

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said A. B. Potter and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said Jessie M. Moreland for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said A. B. Potter and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said A. B. Potter and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, wife of said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 4 of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
