KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

each, payable *at maturity* from this date as evidenced by the *two* promissory notes

seventy five DOLLARS, and all bearing interest from date until paid at the rate of eight per centum per
annum, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said *R. B. Baird*
and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following described property, to-wit: *Lot 13 and in*
in Block *Two (2)* of the Cherokee Heights Addition to the City of Tulsa, in the Western
District of the Indian Territory.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said *R. B. Baird*
his heirs and assigns forever, together with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And the said THE CHEROKEE COMPANY, for the consideration aforesaid, hereby covenants and agrees to and with the said

R. B. Baird
that it will forever warrant and defend the title to said property against all lawful claims.

A lien is hereby retained upon said property to secure the payment of the remainder of the purchase price to become due thereon as above set forth.
