GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

knowledge, do he hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 2 of the second part the following described real estate and

premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: all of my undivided
interest in and to the allotments of Addie Draper
and Rosevelt Briaper, deceased described as follows:
the SE 1/4 of Sec 29 T. 19, N. R. 14 E and the S 1/2 of
the N. W. 1/4 and N. W. 1/4 of N. W. 1/4 and NE 1/4
of S. W. 1/4 of Sec 9 Twp 19 N. R. 14 E containing
320 acres more or less

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said A.A. Kinney
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and - the said George Harrison his
for his heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said A.A. Kinney

and his heirs, successors and assigns, that he lawfully seized in fee of the aforegrant-
ed premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that he have good right to sell and convey the same to said

A.A. Kinney as aforesaid; and that he will and his successors, heirs, executors
and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said A.A. Kinney
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

lease and relinquish unto the said part _____ of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
