premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: *all that portion of Lot No. three (3) in Block No. nine (9) in the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory described and bounded as follows: Beginning at a strip thirty feet in width extending across the center northward side of said Lot 3 in Block 9 and bounded as follows: - Beginning on the north east corner of Lot 3 in Block 18 & thence with the north line of said Lot 140 feet to the north west corner thereof, thence southerly along the westerly line of said Lot 30 feet thence easterly and parallel to the north line of said Lot 140 feet to the East line of said Lot, thence northerly thirty feet with said East line to the place of beginning, according to the survey.*
