

WARRANTY DEED

With Relinquishment of Dower.

Know All Men By These Presents:

the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said and sold, and do by these presents, the following described premises, to wit: ground, bargain, sell and convey unto the said G.
