# WARRANTY DEED

Know All Men By These Presents:

Heckman, a single man of Muskogee, Oklahoma in consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars (\$1000.00) DOLLARS to me in hand paid by which the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said and Trust Company, all his rights, title and interest in and to the following described land the following described premises, to wit located in the Tulsa County, Oklahoma, town of

The south half (½) of the southwest quarter (¼) of the northeast quarter (¼) and the south half (½) of the southeast quarter (¼) of the northwest quarter (¼) and the east half (½) of the southeast ten (10) acres of land two (2) in section thirty-one (31) Township nineteen (19) north range twelve (12) east of the Iardian Base and Meridian containing forty-five (45) acres more or less,
