

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 9th day of August one thousand nine hundred and nine by and between Rachel Bough nee Rachel Childers and John Bough her husband both of Broken Arrow Indian Territory of the first part, and Fred Bukey of Broken Arrow Indian Territory part 2^d of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand \$3000.00 DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 2^d of the second part the following described real estate and

premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: the east one half (1/2) and the south west quarter 1/4 of the north east quarter (1/4) of Section nineteen (19) Township eighteen (18) North Range fourteen (14) east being the allotment of Rachel Bough nee Childers and containing 120 acres more or less

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said Fred Bukey and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and he the said Rachel Bough and John Bough for themselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Fred Bukey and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said Fred Bukey as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Fred Bukey and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Rachel Bough of Broken Arrow Indian Territory wife of said John Bough, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 2^d of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
