

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 13 day of August one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between Cesar Simon unmarried of Conata part 4 of the first part, and Commercial Land Company a corporation of Muskogee part 4 of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said part 4 of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 4 of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The east half of the north east quarter and the south west quarter of the north east quarter of section eleven (11) township eighteen (18) north range thirteen (13) east and containing 12.1 acres more or less according to the official survey thereof

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said Commercial Land Company and its heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said Cesar Simon for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Commercial Land Company and its heirs, successors and assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to and as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Commercial Land Company its heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, _____ of _____ wife of said _____, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part _____ of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
