convey unto the said The Commonwealth Trust Company its successors heirs and assigns
forever, the following described lot or parcel of ground, lying and being situate in the limits of The
Cherokee Northern District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south west quarter S W 4 of north east quarter
N E 4 of north east quarter N E 4 and north west
quarter N W 4 of north east quarter N E 4 all in
section ten (10) township twenty-two (22) north
Range thirteen (13) east of the Indian Meridian
and containing fifty (50) acres of land more or
less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said The Commonwealth Trust Company
its successors heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging. And we, said George Smith
and Betsy Smith hereby covenant with the said The Commonwealth Trust Company that said lands are
free from incumbrances, that we will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all
lawful claims whatever.

And Betsy Smith wife of the said
George Smith for and in consideration of said sum
of money, do hereby release unto the said The Commonwealth Trust Company all my right of
dower and Homestead in and to said lands.
