 convey unto the said The New State Land Co.; its successors heirs and assigns  
 forever, the following described lot or parcel of ground, lying and being situate in the Creek Nation  
 Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The east half of the north-east quarter of  
Section eight (8) and the north half of the  
south-west quarter of Section six (6) and  
and except the homestead allotment of  
George Fields and the west half of the  
south-west quarter of Section Five (5) and  
the south half of the south-west quarter of  
Section six (6) allotment of Nellie Fields all  
in township eighteen (18) north Range thirteen (13) east  
 To have and to hold the same unto the said The New State Land Co.; its successors  
 heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging. And I, George Fields  
 hereby covenants with the said The New State Land Co. that said lands are  
 free from incumbrances, that I will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all  
 lawful claims whatever.

And his wife of the said George Fields  
 for and in consideration of said sum  
 of money, do hereby release unto the said The New State Land Co. all my right of  
 dower and Homestead in and to said lands.
