Two Hundred Dollars to them paid by
J. P. Allen receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and
 convey unto the said J. P. Allen heirs and assigns
 forever, the following described lot or parcel of ground, lying and being situate in the Cherokee
 Nation, of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Ac. 20 1/2 acres Lot 2 sec 6, Twp 23 R. 14.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. P. Allen his
 heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging. And Charles A. Dick and Mary Dick
 hereby covenants with the said J. P. Allen that said lands are
 free from incumbrances, that he will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all
 lawful claims whatever.
 And Mary Dick wife of the said
Charles A. Dick for and in consideration of said sum
 of money, do hereby release unto the said J. P. Allen all my right of
 dower and Homestead in and to said lands.
