

KNOW YE ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Robert Fulson and Lucy Fulson his wife a citizen of the Creek Nation, and a resident of Capulpa Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable considerations to me paid by the Mannford Land Company, a corporation, of Muskogee, Indian Territory, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Mannford Land Company, its successors and assigns forever, the following described lot or parcel of land, lying and being situate in the Creek Nation in Indian Territory, to-wit:

The north half of the south east quarter and the south half of the south half of the south west quarter of the north east quarter of Section thirty three (32) Township nineteen (19) North and Range twelve (12) East.

TO HAVE TO HOLD THE AFOREMENTIONED PREMISES unto the said Mannford Land Company its successors and assigns in fee simple forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging, and I Robert Fulson heirs and assigns, hereby covenants with the said Mannford Land Company that said lands are free from all incumbrances, and that I heirs and assigns will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims whatever.

And Lucy Fulson wife of the said Robert Fulson for the consideration aforementioned do hereby release unto the said Mannford Land Company all my right of Dower and Homestead in and to said lands.
