Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable considerations to me paid by  
the Pawnee Trust Company, a corporation, of Muskogee, Indian Terri-  
tory, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said  
Pawnee Trust Company, its successors and assigns forever, the fol-  
lowing described lot or parcel of land, lying and being situate in the Creek Nation in Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south half of the south east quarter of  
section twenty three 23 and the south half  
of the southeast quarter of section twenty four 24  
township thirty one north and range eleven  
east - was the homestead

TO HAVE TO HOLD THE AFOREMENTIONED PREMISES unto the said Pawnee Trust  
Company its successors and assigns in fee simple forever, with all appurtenances thereunto  
belonging, and I, Dick Arch my heirs and assigns, hereby covenants with the said  
Pawnee Trust Company that said lands are free from all incumbrances, and that  
my heirs and assigns will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims whatever.

And wife of the said  
for the consideration aforementioned do hereby release unto the said  
all my right of Dower and Homestead in and to said lands.
