Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable considerations to me paid by the Pawnee Trust Company, a corporation, of Muskogee, Indian Territory, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Pawnee Trust Company, its successors and assigns forever, the following described lot or parcel of land, lying and being situate in the Creek Nation in Indian Territory, to-wit:

north half of south west quarter and south west quarter of south west quarter of section twenty six of township eighteen (18) of Range fourteen (14)

TO HAVE TO HOLD THE AFOREMENTIONED PREMISES unto the said Pawnee Trust Company its successors and assigns in fee simple forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging, and I John Tiger my heirs and assigns, hereby covenants with the said Pawnee Trust Company that said lands are free from all incumbrances, and that

my heirs and assigns will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims whatever.
