

KNOW YE ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Pompey Barnett heir of Kala mee a citizen of the Creek Nation, and a resident of Kellyville Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable considerations to me paid by the Pawnee Trust Company, a corporation, of Muskogee, Indian Territory, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Pawnee Trust Company, its successors and assigns forever, the following described lot or parcel of land, lying and being situate in the Creek Nation in Indian Territory, to-wit:

The north half of the north west quarter of section eight (8) township nineteen (19) north and range nine (9) east; the north half of the south east quarter and the south half of the north half of the south west quarter of the north east quarter of section thirty-two (32) township nineteen (19) north and range twelve (12) east

TO HAVE TO HOLD THE AFOREMENTIONED PREMISES unto the said Pawnee Trust Company, its successors and assigns in fee simple forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging, and I, Pompey Barnett heirs and assigns, hereby covenants with the said Pawnee Trust Company that said lands are free from all incumbrances, and that I, my heirs and assigns will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims whatever.

And my wife of the said my for the consideration aforementioned do hereby release unto the said my all my right of Dower and Homestead in and to said lands.
