 right, title, interest, claim and demand which said parties
 of the first part in and to the following described lot, piece or
 parcel of land or improvements situated in the Creek
 Nation Indian Territory Western District, and known and
 described as follows to wit:

 west quarter (4) of section twelve (12) Township nineteen (19)
 North, Range twelve (12) east.

And I, Olive H. Houch wife of the said Adrian Houch
 and I, Minnie C. Adams wife of George W. Adams for and in
 consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release
 and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all
 my right of dower and homestead in and to the said land.
