 estate of David McNamee deceased and with David F. Dickey,
 Witness that whereas an order was made by the Probate
 Court of the Western Judicial District of Indian Territory at
 Muskogee, at the October term thereof upon the petition of the said
 Jeanetta McNamee administratrix as aforesaid, she having given
 notice as required by law of her intention to apply for the same,
 which said order authorized and directed the said Jeanetta
 McNamee as administratrix aforesaid, to sell certain real estate
 belonging to the estate of the said David McNamee deceased for the
 payment of debts against said estate, at not less than
 two-thirds the appraised value thereof upon the following terms
 at public auction to the highest and best bidder thereof
 on a credit of three (3) months—

And whereas, the said Jeanetta McNamee administratrix as
 aforesaid, after having said lands appraised according
 to law, by virtue of said order and after complying with
 all the conditions and requirements of the same, and
 having given due notice as required by said order, of the
 time, term and place of sale, did in pursuance of said notice,
