General Warranty Deed.

This Indenture, made this 7th day of December A.D. 1907, between J. C.

Rebholz and Emma Rebholz his wife and H. O. Long and Beena Long his wife, of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and W. Lyle Dickey of the second part.

Witnesseth, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and 100 Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described Real Estate situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

Lot Three (3) in Block (3) Friend & Gillette Addition to the City of Tulsa Okla. according to plat and survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise pertaining forever.

I and said grantors, for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with the said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances, that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances of what nature so ever, bind, whatsoever, except -- and that they will warrant and forever defend the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part, their heirs and all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
